**T**HE within CERTIFICATE shall not avail the bearer as a discharge, until the ratification of the definitive treaty of peace; previous to which time, and until proclamation thereof shall be made, he is to be considered as being on furlough.

Wm. James B. Ginn:

THESE are to CERTIFY that the bearer hereof James Girdler soldier  
in the third Pennsylvania regiment, having faithfully served the  
United States Four years--and seven months and being inlisted for  
the war, is hereby discharged from the American army. Given at Fort  
Pitt Sept 30th 1783
