to solicit your favourable Attention to this Undertaking.

to the American Cause, his Merit in his Profession, and his good
behaviour here, have acquired him such a general Pleasur in
this State, that I hope, You, Sir, will be pleased to excuse the
liberty I take in introducing him to your Acquaintance.
