Washington June 11. 1844

My Dear Sir

I am sincerely sorry to be obliged to trouble you with business, amidst the anxieties which I know surround you, although I know how cheerfully you attend to it. I send you the note endorsed - and also an order ~~on~~ for the dividend on the City stock in order to pay the dividend on the note. I send the order herewith but enclosed in a separate note to you that you may if necessary file it with the order as the witness of your authority to receive the money - I do not know whether it ought to be directed to the Register or Treasurer. You will please give it the right direction & pay the discount on the note with it - and the amount if there is enough - There will I think be some money with a small balance I have in the Bank

I trust your dear little boy is doing well - I need not tell you how many anxious hours I have had since I parted from you - Much love to your wife & the dear children -
