Thomas Soland late of Frederick County yeoman was attached to answer unto John Kitchie in a plea of trespass upon the case and so forth. And whereupon the said John by R. B. Stacey his Attorney, complains, that whereas the said Thomas on the twenty seventh day of February in the year Eighteen Hundred and seven at Frederick County aforesaid accounted together with the aforesaid John of and concerning divers sums of money before that time due and owing from the said Thomas to the said John, and then and there being in arrear and unpaid, and upon that account the said Thomas was then and there found in arrear, and indebted to the said John in the sum of thirty five Dollars and seventy five Cents current money, and being so found in arrear and indebted. The aforesaid Thomas in consideration thereof afterwards, that is to say, the same day and year aforesaid, at the County aforesaid, undertook, and to the said John, then and there faithfully promised, that he the said Thomas would well and truly pay and satisfy to the said John the ~~sum~~ aforesaid sum of thirty five Dollars and seventy five Cents current money when he should be there in thirty days from date of ~~such appearance~~ ~~agreement~~

Notwithstanding the said Thomas although often requested by the said John that is to say on the ^{second} fifth day of April and often afterwards at the County aforesaid hath not yet paid the said sum of money or any part thereof to the said John, but to pay the same or any part thereof to the said John the said Thomas hath hitherto wholly refused and still doth refuse to pay the same to the said John to the damage of the said John in the sum of Sixty dollars Current Money and therefore he brings his suit and to forth.
