Washington, April 3, 1873.

My Dear Lawrence,

I would be glad to have you make inquiry whether <sup>to go out, and the time.</sup> Galbraith is ready, Breese I do not think will answer, I was not very favorably impressed with him.

Middleton & Carman behaved beautifully in regard to that fish, & I have given them a first-rate notice in Harpers Weekly. The duelin cartridges are entirely too big, being suitable for blasting in tunnels & for such work. I want a small cartridge for breaking out fossils from rocks.
