Washington, April 5, 1873.

Dear Lawrence,

A letter dated Feb. 20th forwarded from Sumichrast remarks that "although bearing the address of Mr Lawrence the box of birds, which makes part of the present transmission, is intended for you also, as well as the remainder of it. I only wish that after you have made choice of the species which it may be desirable to keep for your Museum, you will then transmit ^{the collection} it to Mr Lawrence to make a similar selection for his cabinet. As to the rest - I beg that you will see that it is sold to defray expenses which I have undergone."

I do not know to what box he refers. A letter a week earlier announced a box by way of Tehuantepec containing a skin of a tapir & Ocelot.

I have your letter in regard to the Synonite cartridges, for which I am much obliged.
