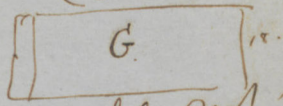

Dear Lawrence

I would however like one set of 4 day blankets, made as gay and bright as fast. blei of the heavy cloth, and if possible with a G (gaudet) in the middle of each.
