Sir

Sheweth unto you Tenpounds Rate  
paper with a request that you will pay for  
a tax in your County, if it be due - The  
land situated is 300 acres in Greenwood  
Township Cumberland 1/2 mile from the  
mouth of Juniata and about 7 miles from  
the mouth - was granted to Abraham Whitman  
some owned by John Kupper who transferred  
it to W. Hill - I know no other circumstances  
respecting <sup>it</sup> but if there should be no person  
on it, it will at the coming sales be sacrificed  
in the mass of non-resident's property.  
Will you take the trouble of enquiring of  
the Commr. whether any or what amount of

be owing - it can surely not exceed the terms  
I send - having some conditional interest in  
the land, and the care of Dr. Keeler, I am  
solicitous to rescue it from a danger that  
may be impending - whatever balance there  
may be you may remit me at leisure -
