Dear Sir

On 2 April I answered your letters of June & Novr 1786, & sent you a parcel by Captn. Ritchie of the Alexander directed as you desired to the care of Mr Ro. Aiken Bookseller. I have had no letters from you since, but Mr. Creech had a letter dated in March in which Dr. Rush writes him to acquaint me that your Colledge was prospering & you & they happy in each other.

I think by the well disposed members of the present General Assembly, it is better complexioned than some former ones. But there is no concert. Some are too old, others too indifferent or political, & others too young and of too little influence to set such a matter a going.

I think I wrot you in April of Dr. [William] Mcgill's weak but yet dangerous book on the death of Christ [A practical essay on the death of Christ, 1786]. Dr. Dalrymple has a book in the press on the life of Christ, & Dr [James] Wodrow of [Stevenston?] is said to be composing a life of Dr [William] Leechman [Sermons: to which is prefixed some account of the author's life and of his lectures, 1789]. Miss Gillies was lately married to Captn. David Leslie. The Assembly this day in a Committee of the whole house have unanimously voted the deposition of Mr. Mcintosh of [Mory?]. A previous vote yesternight not to remit the cause to the synod, but this day to proceed to judgment, carried by 16. This is the 6th year of the cause. It has cost the parish 600 pound sterl.
