1857 Letter from R. B. Janey

Dated 5 April 1857

R. B. TANEY to D. M. Perine, Esq., Baltimore.....Washington, April 5, 1857.A.L.S. My Dear Sir

I was much broken down in the last two weeks of the Supreme Court & not able to get into the street for a fortnight afterwards -But I hope I shall be well enough to be in Baltimore on next Monday evening & be ready for court the next day -
