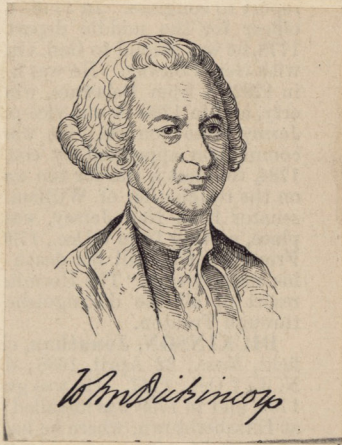

For £54<sup>9</sup>/<sub>2</sub> specie In Council Philadelphia October 8<sup>th</sup> 1783

Sir Capt John Hays Esquire fifty four pounds nine shillings  
and two pence state money, of the seventh of April 1781 - being the  
balance due to him in state money, as late Sub Lieutenant for the  
County of Northampton - to be paid out of the money arising from  
Militia fines in said County.
