My dear Sir —

I hereby appoint you Principal  
of the Grammar School of Dickinson  
College until the meeting of the Board  
of Trustees in July, accordy to resolution  
of Superintending Committee, dated  
April 1<sup>st</sup> 1840 —

This matter is now settled until  
July, & what course will then be taken I  
am now unable to say — I think I can  
give you pretty definite information  
on my return — Take possession of the  
Room in Gram. School, have an  
interview with Mr Bourman as soon as  
he arrives, & let us see if we cannot raise  
the school once more —
