Wheatland, 7 April 1864

My dear James.

Pardon me for imposing upon you a duty which I trust you will find more agreeable than that pertaining to Miss Lynch. Several persons have discharged their Bonds & Mortgages to me since the first of April & I now wish you to send them to me. I presume Adams Express would be the best & cheapest mode of transportation as they are really of no intrinsic value. I give you the list.

Magdalena Urban. Bonds & Mortgage 27 March 1861.

John Hough, Henry Welsh & al. Two Bonds. 1 April 1862.

Thomas & Henry Baumgardner. Bonds & Mortgage 17 Jan: 1857

Horatio S. Kerns & J. W. Rutter, Bonds & Mortgage 31 March 1860.

George S. Hamilton ————— Bond ————— 1 December 1856

J. B. Baker. Bonds & unrecorded Mortgage ————— 2 April 1863.

You might also transmit the agreement between J. B. Baker & myself dated the 15 August 1862.

There is I believe, also in the Tin Box a note from O. Barnett & Co dated 16 July 1860 for \$1000. This you might transmit by Mail with the accompanying papers; — as well as a Single Bill from John B. Hertzler & Henry Baereman for for \$1000 dated 1 August 1862.

There will be 8 Coupons of \$30 each due me on the 2 May from the Little Miami R. R. Company. To save you additional trouble you might cut them off & keep them until they become due.

I am sorry to give you this trouble; but I do not at present desire to send for the Tin Box. There is no haste so that you may suit your own convenience
