I shall however, continue at Birmingham <u>if possible</u>, and resume all my pursuits, in which case I must trouble you for a fresh stock of <u>retorts</u>, <u>tubes</u> &c &c &c. This invasion of the Goths and Vandals I little foresaw, and hope it will never be repeated, as I fancy the <u>experiment</u> will not be found to answer.
