Dear Annie

I have a letter from
Charley wanting to know when
we are coming that we may
engage rooms.

I want to go at once
if you are ready — It is now
the 14th of June Monday —
I am going down to get the
flannel for a bathing dress
& to settle up my accounts &
I would like to start Monday
week. June 21. Can't you come
on & spend Sunday with us
& then we'll start together
please ~~telegraph me~~ ^{write with these delay}
if you can do this — I do
not love to travel alone
& as we are going in night

wile go together

I think of stopping over night
at Mrs Cluflins at Newtonville
& going on the next day - She
wile be delighted to see you
& you wile enjoy seeing her
lovely place & surroundings
I shall write to Charley to engage
one room from the 21st of course
we^r room together. The room rent
a matter of much consequence
as we shall be out of doors all
the time.

Now as to baby clothes I have
got the little dresses & flannel
skirts here but if you wile
bring me 4 bands & four
forming blankets I wile
pay you for them when
you arriv.

I enclose something for
Jack to help make up
a little book he knows
of I have written three times
to him & got no answer
& feel quite cut
