My dear Susie

About our room — I roomed
last summer with Mrs Munroe
very comfortably — As to sulking
if I want to do that I will
engage a closet extra to do
it in. As to getting mad with
you — well I never did it
& I don't know how it should
be arranged — & I never dreamed
of your getting mad at me —

but if expence is any object
a single room is just double
we can have a room for
9 each but one would be
charged 18 — I don't expect
to do any thing but sleep
in mine I am going to live
out doors — I fear I must

I don't believe I shall go quite
as early as Monday - but I
set an early day for the sake
of murrising up matters - I want

Sunday if next week - &
if possible to get them to
be with Charley at his Friday
