Memorandum of an agreement made the first day of April One thousand
eight hundred and nine between John Wilson of the Township of Buckingham and
County of Bucks Doctor of the one part and Seth Cattell now of the same place Doctor
of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Wilson for and in consideration of the
sum of six hundred Dollars annually to him paid or secured to be paid by the said Seth
Cattell on the first day of every April succeeding the date hereof for and during the full term
of seven years hath demised and set to use the whole circle and extent of his medical
and surgical practice where so ever it may extend or be bounded. To have & to hold all
and singular the demised medical and surgical practice unto the said Seth Cattell his
Heirs and assigns for and during the full term of seven years from the day of the date
hereof. And during the said term of seven years the said John Wilson shall not appropriate
any of the profits arising from said circle or scope of medical or surgical practice which
he now occupies unto himself or do its grates except in case of his own family or in some
chance case such as has been his former practice; but the profits thereof whether done by
the said John Wilson or Seth Cattell or by either of their orders are to go directly to the
said Seth Cattell for and during the term of seven years as aforesaid. And while the said Seth
Cattell shall board and lodge with the said John Wilson he is to have the use of his
shop and medical furniture with the careful use of his medical Books and surgical
Instruments. The said Seth Cattell is also to have the use of the medicines now on hand in
said Shop to be inventoried as well as the shop furniture and to replace them in equal
quantity and quality at the expiration of the said term of seven years. And for the true
performance and faithful accomplishment of all and singular the above Articles of agreement
the said parties as well as Peter Cattell do bind themselves each unto the other in the penal
sum of two thousand Dollars. In witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their
hands & seals the day and year first above written.
