came with the Court of Common Pleas held at Dover on and for Kent County on  
November the twelfth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand  
seven hundred and sixty six and made with me on the day bearing witness of things  
seen heard and rightly and made with me on the day bearing witness of things  
by the two John Dickinson before sign seal, duly execute and deliver the within  
Deed and power of Attorney as has before said, and was signed by the said John Dickinson  
as a witness thereto at the same time and that the Deponent did state for the name as one other  
witness to the same, *W. M. M.* came into the same Court Nicholas Bondie, Attorney at Law and by  
virtue of the power and authority unto him given then and there did acknowledge the within Deed unto William  
Allen together with the said John Dickinson. Thence proceeded to be his Right and Property according to the  
said Deed and power of Attorney. *W. M. M.* Testimony whereof I have hereunto placed the Public Seal of  
said County aforesaid.
