Washington 28 December 1847

My dear Sir,

I have received your kind letter & owe you my grateful thanks for your uniform & efficient friendship. It will afford me great pleasure to meet Mr. Gort & yourself in this city.

Luzerne is, I think, one of the few Counties in the State which is hostile to me. You say that "our friend Beaumont, is operating very extensively"; but from what I learn it is against myself. He never had been friendly to me; but I ^{had} supposed he ~~had~~ left this City with feelings somewhat changed. It is certain that I took a part in favor of his ~~nominations~~ confirmation.

General Shields arrived here yesterday evening & I saw him to day. He looks quite as well as he ever did & says that he feels no inconvenience from having ^{had} a grape shot ^{nearly} as large as an egg ~~shot~~ through his lungs! This is almost a miracle. He was badly wounded in the arm & has it in a sling.
