a gain for it has been a long Time dear son since you where at home but we hope it may not be very long till you get home now i wish you had your discharge now that you could come now for we would be very glass to see you I hope you will not be sent in to eny more battles for you have done your dully like a good boy Dear son v will send you of one dollars in this letter i høpe you will get it we all send our love to you and hope you will get home Safe a gain write from if you how con and let us know, you permain your tru Mother Agnes

#### Carlisle May the 1 1864
