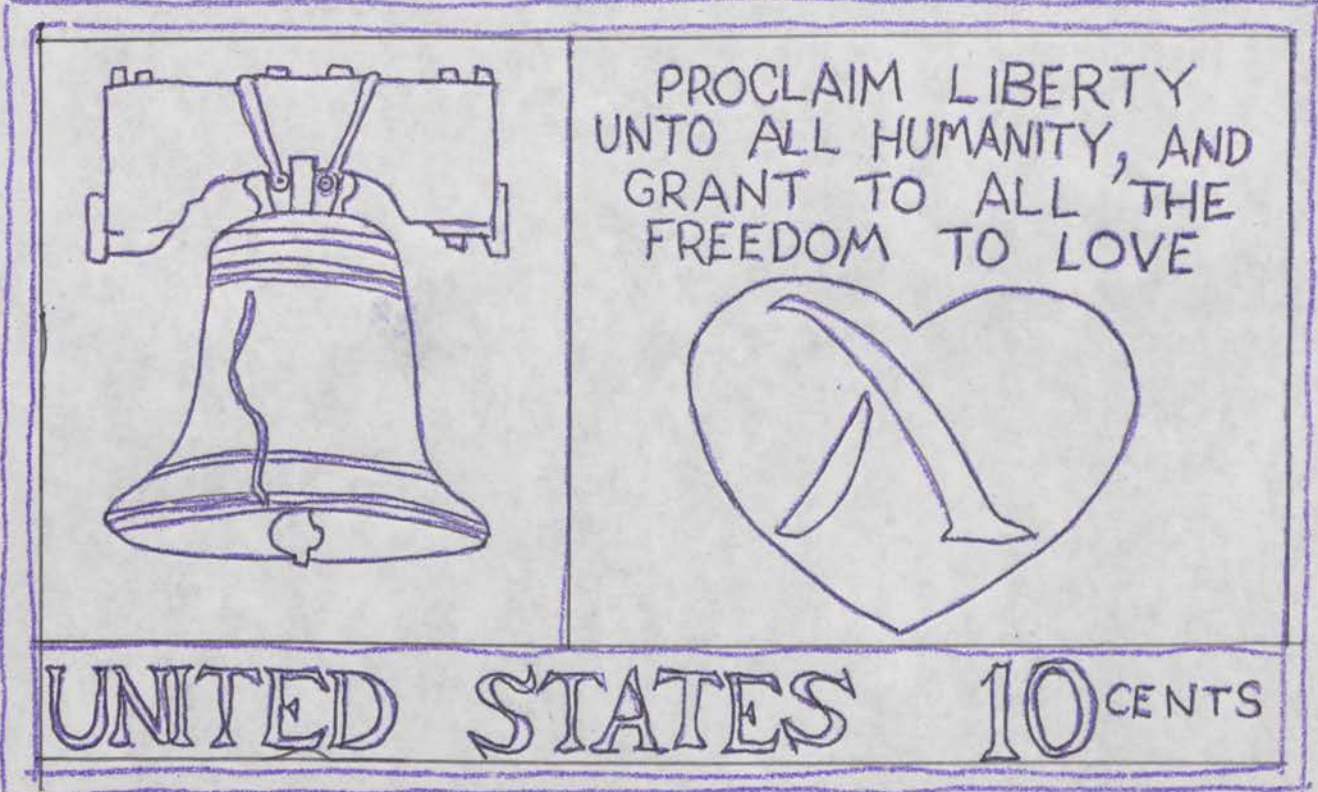

The stamp design drawn below was originated by the Art Alliance of the Gay Coordinating Society of Reading, Pa. and proposed by G. C. S. for issue to the Citizens Stamp Advisory in Washington. The color of the stamp is red, white, and blue.
