BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Dan Miller was born in 1956 in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. He graduated from Central Dauphin High School and earned his BA in Accounting from Elizabethtown College, later going on to get his MA in Finance from Penn State University. In October of 1990, after working for Donald L. DeMuth Professional Management Consultants as an accountant, Dan was fired for being gay. After the trial process, which Miller did not win, he continued to be an activist within the LGBT Community of Central PA.

Miller ran for mayor of Harrisburg, PA in 2013. While he was not successful in that election, he has held numerous positions of leadership. At the time of the mayoral campaign, he was the Harrisburg City Controller from 2010 to 2014 and Harrisburg's first openly gay elected official. He is a former member of the city council in Harrisburg. He founded the Business Association of Gays and Lesbians in Harrisburg (now called the Central PA Gay and Lesbian Chamber of Commerce), founded the PA Justice Campaign, co-founded the Pride Festival of Central PA, and co-founded the Community Recognition Banquet (later re-named FAB or Fall Achievement Banquet).

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection is organized into four categories: Campaign Materials, Photographs, Media, and Artifacts. The Campaign Materials contains flyers from Dan Miller's election campaigns, primarily his run for mayor in 2013. The Photographs category includes photos from the 1994 Harrisburg Pride Festival, as well as the first Community Recognition Banquet in the early 1990s, which took place at Miss

Garbo's Tea Room at 22 South Hanover Street, Carlisle, PA. Miscellaneous items include a brochure by the Gay and Lesbian Switchboard of Harrisburg, and a book and accompanying letter sent to Miller. The Media grouping contains a VHS tape that features the story of Dan Miller's fight for gay rights after being fired for being gay in 1990. The Artifacts series contains a campaign pin from Miller's run for mayor of Harrisburg, as well as the original VHS case of Dan Miller's featured story.
