BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

John Barns was born in Perry County, PA. He graduated from Greenwood High School in 1960 and then joined the Pennsylvania National Guard during the Vietnam War, where he was in the armored tank division. After discharging from the military, Barns worked for the State in the Department of Labor and Industry and The Department of Health. He was a state employee for 30 years. Barns was a member of Dignity/Central PA, a Roman Catholic based organization that was a place for LGBTQ+ community members of any religious background to be together in community; and a part of the Gay Switchboard of Harrisburg, a telephone service that gave information, referrals, and supportive counseling to members of the local LGBTQ+ community.

Barns lives in Central PA today.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains 6 series: Newspaper and Magazine Clippings; Dignity/Central PA; Cards and Postcards; Montreal, Quebec, Canada LGBTQ+ Information; Miscellaneous; and Artifacts.

The Newspaper and Magazine Clippings series holds clippings from a wide variety of publications, not limited to Central PA, addressing LGBTQ+ issues related to marriage, clergy, politics, discrimination, and the military. The Dignity/Central PA series contains items pertaining to

Dignity/Central PA events and notes. Cards and Postcards series holds postcards and greeting cards designed with LGBTQ+ community in mind.

The Montreal, Quebec, Canada LGBTQ+ Information series holds brochures, pamphlets, and publications from Montreal, Quebec that discuss LGBTQ+ health, specifically HIV/AIDS. The Miscellaneous series contains personal correspondence, bookmarks, single LGBTQ+ publications, posters, and a scrapbook created by Barns about the movie *Brokeback Mountain*, which premiered in 2006. Finally, the Artifact Collection contains LGBTQ+ items from Central PA and Montreal, Quebec.
