BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Colin Kreitzer was born in 1947 in Enola, Pennsylvania, and grew up in Wormleysburg, PA with his parents and his younger sister. He attended West Chester College (now West Chester University) and moved to Harrisburg in 1977, where he began getting involved in the gay community through activism and social activities. Kreitzer was involved in the Gay Switchboard of Harrisburg (GSH), later known as the Gay and Lesbian Switchboard of Harrisburg (GLSH), Dignity/Central PA, Metropolitan Community Church (MCC) of the Spirit, and volleyball.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains 6 series: Newspaper Clippings, Magazine Articles, Gay Switchboard of Harrisburg (GSH), MCC of the Spirit, Miscellaneous, and Photographs.

The Newspaper Clippings series include pieces on Ellen DeGeneres's coming out and other LGBTQ+ news, primarily from Harrisburg and Philadelphia newspapers. The Magazine Articles series includes articles on LGBTQ+ issues surrounding entertainment and marriage. The Gay Switchboard of Harrisburg (GSH) series holds items from an outreach event, "That Rabbit" play series, and a GSH newsletter. The MCC of the Spirit series holds a copy of the *Gayfolio* newsletter and a Sunday service program. The Miscellaneous holds a Dignity/Central PA Keystone Newsletter and pictures of famous

LGBTQ+ people. Finally, the Photographs include colored picture slides of the Pride Parade in New York City.
