BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Tapestry Magazine, alternately known as Tapestry, Transgender Tapestry, The TV-TS Tapestry, and The Tapestry Journal throughout its history, was first published in the late 1970s. The publication appeared in a variety of formats until the early 2000s. The publication was founded by Merissa Sherrill Lynn and was published first by the Tiffany Club and later by the International Foundation for Gender Education, IFGE.

Using the recognized language of its time within the LGBTQ+ community, the publication covered topics in relation to the transgender community such as politics, media, fashion, gender expression, social events, etc. The IFGE website describes the publication as "*Transgender Tapestry* is a publication by, for, and about all things trans, including crossdressing, transsexualism, intersexuality,

FTM, MTF, butch, femme, drag kings and drag queens, androgyny, female and male impersonation, and more. We are a leading source for stimulating dialogue covering a wide range of gender topics, from medical and psychological care to family and partner issues, to film and book reviews, and much more. We are the *only* trans publication with a complete listing of trans support groups."

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains materials found in issues of Tapestry magazine (1993-1995). The collection contains materials promoting the magazine's current (to the issues) publisher, the International Foundation for Gender Education, as well as promotional materials for events hosted by Tapestry's original publisher, the Tiffany Club of New England. The materials contained in this collection focus on publications, conferences, social events, and trips about and for transgender individuals and their allies.

Note to researchers: These inserts were found in issues of Tapestry that were left at the LGBT Center of Central Pennsylvania and then donated to the LGBT History Project at Dickinson College. It is unknown if these inserts were distributed in every issue of Tapestry magazine or if these inserts were placed in the magazines by their original owner.
