## **Health Spotlight**

March is National Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month. Did you know that colorectal cancer is the second-leading cause of cancer-related deaths in the U.S. for both men and women combined?

Colorectal cancer is highly preventable. It can be caught in its earliest, most curable stages through screening tests. If discovered early, it's up to 90 percent curable. However, many people are too embarassed to talk about this subject with their doctors. Don't bel

Our most effective defense against this disease are: regular cancer screening, and a low-fat diet high in fruits and vegetables. While a diet high in fruits and vegetables may not prevent this disease, this diet does provide overall health benefits and is still recommended.

The risk of developing colorectal cancer does increase with age. Everyone over the age of 50 should be tested regularly for this disease. Minorities, particularly African-Americans and Hispanics, are at a higher risk for this disease and should be tested at an earlier age.
