# PATRIOT-NEWS GIVES GAYS CLOUT

The Business section of the Harrisburg Patriot News ran a Dec.1,'91 special on the business clout of Gays and Lesbians. Gay male households have an average income of \$51,325; Lesbian households average \$45,927, compared to the national average of \$36,000. Of the 4% of people in the U.S. that earn over \$100,000, 15% are Gay Males, 3% Lesbians. In a national survey of 20,000 Gay people the total Gay market is \$394 billion.

In June'91 Shell Oil was ordered to pay \$5.3 million for firing Jeffrey Collins because he was Gay. In Oct.'91 Lotus Development Corp. offered benefits to partners of Gay employees. Ben and Jerry's (Ice Cream) Inc. has offered health benefits to Gays and Lesbians since 1989.

30.1% of all Gays and Lesbians have advanced college degrees. 62% of Gay males are college graduates, 59% of Lesbians, compared to all men-24% and all women-17%. 39.1% of Gays and Lesbians vacationed outside the US in '91. 65.3% of Lesbians go camping.

It sounds like we're doing well and having fun.
