While we are fighting to be recognized as valuable members of society, there is another group equally fighting to ensure that it doesn't happen. Conservative religious groups, including millions of Christian Fundamentalists, are banding together to vote for a conservative administration who will appoint conservative Supreme Court Justices. The freedoms that have been granted to us can be taken away! They want to re-establish "Family Values". (This means there is no room in their plan for Alternative Lifestyles.) The movement is strong and should not be underestimated.
