Basically, this means that under Colorado Law, Gay's have no rights. Instead of Boycotting the Ski Week, the organizers of the event are calling for tens of thousands of Gays & Lesbians to come to town to protest the Amendment. "The blacks did not leave Alabama. They marched on Selma. We are not going to the back of the bus. We are not accepting bigotry. We are coming to Aspen." says Robin Tyler, one of the event's producers. "I don't care if a Gay skis or not. Every Gay or Lesbian should get their ass in Colorado for the Gay Ski Week." Typically, the Ski Week was a social event full of parties & skiing, this year it is packed with fundraisers and lectures, along with a long list of celebrities & politicians who are invited to join the protest. 
