

THE LAW AND YOU



Q: My partner and I are not wealthy by any means. We both work and haverather average incomes. But we do think it is important to think about our future. In your column, we have learned a lot about wills, a health surrogate, and other important things. But now, we are starting to think about our financial future. My father keeps reminding me about the importance of investing, and I really don't want to discuss with him all of our personal finances. Would it be of help for my partner and I to see a financial advisor, and perhaps the most important part of my question, is it expensive?

A. Your question is one that frequently is presented to attorneys. After a couple has considered the legal aspects of estate planning, health surrogacy, advanced directives, and other important life decisions, it is important to have some sort of financial road map to follow in your lives. While no-one can precisely predict future needs or resources, it is extremely helpful to carefully consider various possibilities. Gay couples are wise to think about their individual and joint financial goals. It is never too early to begin planning and to take at least some "baby steps" towards reaching your goals.

A financial advisor is someone who could be of great assistance to you in defining your goals, then discussing your options and working with you in the implementation of a plan which meets your particular needs. Many stock brokerage firms have financial advisors on their staff who are willing to meet brokerage firms have financial advisors on their staff who are willing to meet with you, at no charge for the initial conference. Before making an appointment, it is important to clarify that the first meeting is complimentary. At that first meeting, you and your partner should feel free to discuss any and all of your concerns. For example: Are you concerned about planning for a comfortable retirement? Are you concerned about protecting one of you financially if the other should die or become seriously ill? Are you concerned about minimizing taxes? Are you concerned about saving/investing for a child's future educational needs? Are you perhaps confused about the

Ideally, a financial advisor would be an individual who understands the Ideally, a financial advisor would be an individual who understands the nature of your same-sex relationship. How do you find such a person? Well, you may seek a referral from other gay people whose opinions you respect or you may through the "grapevine" learn of a gay-friendly financial advisor. It is especially important that you feel totally comfortable with a financial advisor. She should not make you feel intimidated or embarrassed in any manner whatsoever. You must feel free to ask questions and she must answer those questions in a manner that is understandable for you. Different levels of understanding about financial matters. people have different levels of understanding about financial matters

After the initial meeting, you can take your time and decide for yourself if you want to pursue a continuing relationship with a particular financial advisor. You should never feel pressured and you should thoroughly understand any future fee arrangements. There are a plentitude of investment programs available in today's world; and your financial advisor should explain them, along with any fees associated with them. You need to determine for yourself what program best fits your needs. Without professional financial advice, you could make some very common and very costly mis-
