



Health Spotlight....

POISON IVY

It's summertime!! Poison ivy time! Gardners get it, hikers get it, kids and pets get it. It's everywhere! This bad weed grows in all of the lower 48 states, and can appear as a small shrub, or a woody, ivy-like vine. We all remember the old saying, "leaves of 3 let it be", well, it doesn't always have leaves of 3.

The worst part of the poison ivy plant is the oil that comes from it, called urushiol. This is usually a colorless oil, but sometimes it might appear as light yellow. Sensitivity to the oil is the single most common cause of allergic skin reaction in the U.S., AND it's the leading cause of worker's compensation payments related to outdoor injuries. What happens when you come in contact with the oil? Well, if you don't wash it off right away, you will develop redness in the area of contact within 2 to 6 hours if you are highly sensitive. If you are not highly sensitive it could take up to 2 weeks before you experience any rash. After the rash comes some swelling, followed by blisters which eventually erupt and discharge fluid, which eventually crusts over in the final stage. During this time you are in mis-

What do you do now that you have it? You can use calamine lotion, or if it's really bad, go to the doctor to get prednisone, which will help. Not all calamine lotions are the same. Look for one that has the highest concentration of calamine in it. Stay away from any that have antihistimines or anesthetics in the ingredients, they could make things worse. Read the labels! You can try these drying agents also: oatmeal bath, epsom salt bath, and ocean water. These do help!

Prevention: wear long pants and sleeves when you know you will be around it. When you get home, strip and launder the clothes right away, and YOU take a shower immediately to wash off any oil you might have come in contact with while taking off the clothes. There are also ivy-blocks you can buy at the drugstore that you can put on any exposed skin while you are outdoors. These do work as long as you follow the directions! Look for ones that are FDA approved! These will cost about \$10 - \$15, but they are worth every penny!
