## MONEYtalk....

### WOMEN AND RETIREMENT

(Provided by Janney Montgomery Scott)

A recent survey shows that 68 percent of women don't know how much income they will need in retirement to supplement Social Security and/or pension benefits. This statistic is important, because women, even more than men, can expect to live many years after they leave the work force and must prepare carefully in order to remain self-supporting.

Trying to ensure a financially secure life after you retire (or even being able to retire) often depends on decisions made decades earlier. A slight difference in the amount you put aside each year, or a subtle shift in investments - stocks, bonds, CDs, mutual funds, etc. - can make a huge difference in the size of your eventual nest egg. This nest egg is especially important for gay women because gay couples do not currently qualify for many benefits that straight couples do (such as survivor Social Security benefits when your partner passes away).

According to "Women's Cents," a project sponsored by The National Center for Women and Retirement Research (NCWRR), Working Woman magazine, and Prudential Securities, women usually have the right ideas about money and investing, but they vary enormously in their success at putting those ideas to work, largely due to personality traits. Assertiveness, openness to change, and an optimistic outlook are the characteristics that were found to tend to lead to sound investment decisions. What can women do to develop the positive mental attitudes that correlate so strongly with successful investing?

**Fight fear of the unknown with knowledge.** Good information on investing can be found in libraries, book stores, and seminars, or by contacting a financial advisor willing to help you learn about investing.

**Don't hesitate, automate.** Above all, successful retirement planning requires investing regularly, month after month. Take advantage of automated services to make the practice as effortless as possible. Of course, you should consider your financial ability and willingness to continue purchasing through periods of low price levels.

**Start slow, start small.** New investors can begin investing in small amounts to help avoid undue anxiety about short-term setbacks.

**Stay in touch with winners.** Friends and colleagues who have been successful in managing their investments can be an invaluable source of inspiration and advice.
