Health Spotlight

WOMEN: CHECK YOUR GENITALS MONTHLY

I'm not kidding on this. How does one check that area and what are we looking for? Well, you could use a hand mirror, or have your partner or girlfriend check for you. What you are looking for is new lumps or bumps or spots that look like freckles down there. If you have something there and it stays for longer than a month, or seems to be getting bigger, please consult with your gynecologist. This could indicate anything from a benign cyst to cancer.

Check to see if the skin of the vulva is becoming thinner and more wrinkled, which could be a sign of lichen sclerosis, a non-cancerous skin condition marked by itching. Not sure what exactly the vulva is? The vulva surrounds the outside opening of the vagina and clitoris. The vulvar skin is very sensitive, and reacts to a wide range of allergens that include colored or scented toilet paper, fabric softener sheets, soaps of any kind, and nylon underwear. Women can become allergic to products that they have used for many years. Creams are available to treat the itching, and then of course you must avoid the allergen that triggered the allergic response.

Do you have a painful clitoris? It could be a sign that past or current sexual practices are irritating the clitoris. Or it could be vulvodynia, a condition in which symptoms occur without visible surface changes. There are numerous treatments available for this condition.

The clitoris can grow due to hormonal changes. This is caused by the adrenal glands overproducing male hormones, which can cause the clitoris to grow and become uncomfortable.

If you see or feel any changes down there, please make an appointment with your doctor and get it checked out.
