## Mz. Kleen sez....

Do you have some bumper stickers on your car from the last election that you would like to remove? You probably tried to remove them but found you couldn't......what do you do?

Try this:

- 1. Spray the sticker with a lubricant such as WD-40, and try to peel it off. If this doesn't work, proceed to step 2.
- 2. Soften the adhesive with heat from a blow dryer.
- 3. Start to peel off a corner of the sticker while continuing to apply heat, or gently scrape off the sticker with a rubber spatula or a putty knife with its metal blade wrapped in duct tape. Do not use a razor blade; it can scratch paint and bumpers.
- Wipe the remains of the sticker away with a soft, lint-free rag dampened with rubbing alcohol.
- Buff the bumper or panel with a polishing compound and a fresh coat of wax to complete the job.
