



Health Spotlight

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM THE SUN

Are you one of those people who go out in the beginning of summer and get a bad sunburn because you think that it will help you tan faster? I know a few people that really do that the first couple times they are out in the summer. They feel it's a faster way to a nice tan.

Actually, it just might be a faster way to getting skin cancer. Sunburn is actually a sign of skin injury. Too much sun can cause sunburn, wrinkles, freckles, skin texture changes, dilated blood vessels, rash problems and worst of all, deadly skin cancers.

Learn how to enjoy the sun safely. The American Academy of Dermatology offers these suggestions:

- * Use a broad-spectrum sunscreen with a SPF of at least 15 on all exposed skin, including the lips, even on cloudy days.
- * If exposed to water, either through swimming or sweating, a water-resistant sunscreen should be used.
- * Reapply sunscreen frequently.
- * Wear a broad-brimmed hat and sunglasses.
- * Sit in the shade whenever possible.
- * Wear protective, tightly-woven clothing.
- * Plan outdoor activities early or late in the day to avoid peak sunlight hours between 10 AM and 4 PM.
