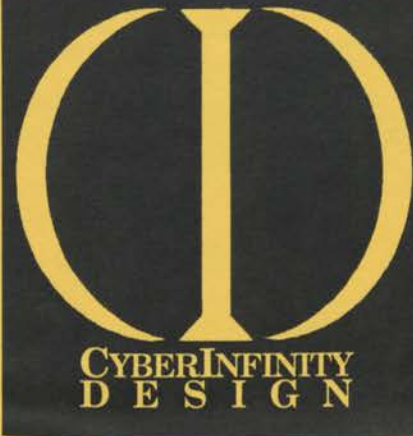

Health Spotlight....

OCTOBER IS BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

Early signs: A depression is found in an area of the breast surface; a portion of the skin on the breast or underarm swells and has an unusual appearance; the breast nipple becomes inverted, develops a rash, changes in skin texture, or has a discharge other than breast milk; a lump is detected, which is usually single, firm and most often painless; veins on the skin surface become more prominent on one breast. Women's breasts can develop some degree of lumpiness, but only a small percentage of lumps are malignant.

Facts: Every 2 minutes a woman is diagnosed with breast cancer; 1,600 men are expected to be diagnosed with breast cancer this year and 400 are predicted to die; breast cancer is the leading cause of death in women between the ages of 40 and 55; 70 % of all breast cancers are found through breast self-exams. Not all lumps are detectable by touch. Regular mammograms and monthly self-exams are recommended.

Detection Plan: Clinical breast exams every 3 years from age 20-39, then every year thereafter; monthly breast self-examinations beginning at age 20; baseline mammogram by the age of 40; mammogram every 1 - 2 years for women 40 - 49 depending on previous findings; mammogram every year for women 50 and older; a personal calendar to record your self-exams, mammograms, and doctor appointments; and a low-fat diet, regular exercise, and no smoking or drinking.
