INVESTING—HOW TO GET STARTED
(Provided by Prudential Securities)

If you are just getting started in investing, you should follow a few basic steps: *Determine your objectives and understand your current financial position. There are many reasons for investing, such as: earning more current income; saving for a home, education, or retirement; or reducing your taxes. Just as you wouldn't buy a Corvette to go four-wheeling, different objectives suggest distinct strategies and investments. For example, if you want more income, you might do better with a fixed income investment, such as a bond, rather than a company's stock.

*Understand your investment. Before you invest, understand how an investment works, perhaps by reading a company's annual report or a mutual fund's prospectus.

*If you don't have the time or resources to determine appropriate investments, seek professional advice. An experienced financial advisor can help you at every step—from helping you set financial goals, to explaining various investments, to implementing and monitoring the success of your investments. As with your investments, be sure you understand how a financial advisor will charge for his or her services, if there is a charge, and select an advisor with whom you can be comfortable in discussing your personal situation.
