## LILY WHITE & COMPANY HISTORY

1980: *Lily & Company* is formed.

1985 - 1988: February and August drag shows are performed at The Stallions. All tips collected are donated to the South entral AIDS Assistance Network (SCAAN).

1988: The *Third Street Players*, an acting arm of Lily & Company, perform Larry Kramer's play *The Normal Heart* at the Rose Lehrman Arts Center on the HACC campus. Proceeds go to SCAAN.

1989: Annual August show---*Foreign Affairs*---is performed at the Holiday Inn Town for the first time with over \$3,000 going to SCAAN. The show is repeated at Altland's Ranch in York with proceeds given to York's AIDS organization.

A Board is established and By-Laws adopted the following year. The organization is formally known as *Lily White & Company*. *Lily* becomes incorporated in 1992.

1990: Lily Patient Relief Fund (LPRF) for AIDS orgs is established. Lily's Community Fund for gay and lesbian groups and the Lily Light Fund for equipment purchases are established in 1992.

1991: Regular Paper Moon cabarets begin with tips earmarked for SCAAN. Regular Strawberry Cafe shows begin in 1993 to raise funds for company productions so more is donated to organizations.

Lily travels to Lancaster's Days Inn to help raise funds for Eagles' Wing Hospice.

The Lily production *Lost in Paradise* is performed at

Illusions raising yet more funds for the LPRF.

1992: *Leather & Lamé* is performed at Club Raje in conjunction with The Pennsmen's Run (funds go to the LPRF).

First performance of Lily show *Something Old, Someone New* takes place at The D-GEM.

Second August show at The Harrisburg Hotel (formerly Holiday Inn Town) is performed. *Hysteria of the World According to Lily* raises over \$10,000 for SCAAN, Hospice of Central Pennsylvania and York House Hospice. Show is later performed at York's Mackley's Mill raising additional funds for York House Hospice.

1993: Shows for The Pennsmen (at The Riverfront Inn) and Parents and Friends of Lesbians and Gays (PFLAG)---*Something Old, Someone New II*---(at the Harrisburg Hotel) are performed with tips going to the LPRF.

Lily White & Company, Inc. performs its second play--- Terrance McNally's *The Lisbon Traviata*---at Open Stage of Harrisburg. With \$3000 donated to York House Hospice, Lily's total benevolence reaches \$35,000!

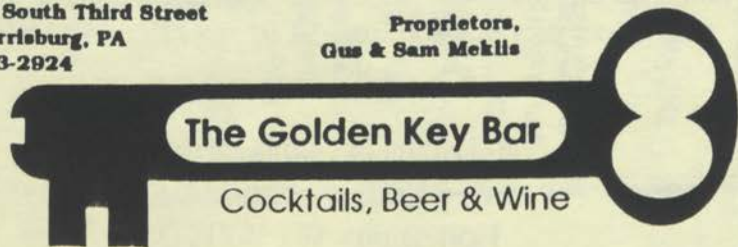
