THE BIG NEWS this month is that the Conference has finally settled for good at the Hourd Johnsons Notor Lodge in Delaware Mater Gap. Having been refused by two other hotels in the final stages of negotiations, we have had no choice but to accept their offer, which was made after the story of discrimination by the Americus Notel and the Genetti Notels was published in the Allenton Horning Call. Holiday Inn West in Allenton also offered, but their costs, lack of spare rooms for work shops and other factors made it impossible. Also, we must note, a really fine offer from the Millersville State College Gay Americas group to host the conference, in which community based housing would have to be found. We have felt from the beginning that the usual problems conferences pass were enough without the added burden of finding housing for so many. The Committee is projecting an attendance of about 250 people.

The lodge is beautifully arranged for this conference. The main meeting room breaks down into various sized workshop spaces, the sleeping rooms are immediately adjacent to the meeting room, and there is an indoor heated swiming pool to enjoy.

Finally, the lodge is easily accessible by good roads, and easily found without further instructions than that it is located just off Route 80 (Interstate), from the last exit before the Jersy border.

Lest north, obviously, the Grucus was saved by more than a quorum. The body avoided the constitutional crisis it was in by voting unanimously to suspend the rules on nominations and elections, and to defer elections one month later than stated in the by-laws. The officers times elected, will serve 11 month terms, in order to bring us back in line with the constitution.

Hominations will be accepted up until the actual elections.
However, people nominated at the next meeting must be present, or prior consent obtained that they will serve if elected, if the nominees are not present. The sols qualification is that a nominee be a voting member of the Caucus at the time he or she is nominated.

The information on the conference (entrance fees, room rates, speakers, workshops will be sent in a special mailing in early December. Jatch for it. And by all means plan to attend. Its going to be a really exciting and especially intimate conference.
