## CAUCUS MINUTES FEB. '78

After considerable delay, the Caucus convened at the Friends Meeting House in Harrisburg at 6th & Herr Sts. The meeting was entirely concerned with the rescheduled conference, Pride '78, and was conducted by Mary N., co-chair. The main concern was with the distribution of the new pamphlets which will be prepared by the staff of the <u>Gay Era</u> at a considerably low cost to the Caucus. The possibility of an arrangement with the Penna. Council for Sexual Minorities for use of their mailing resources was explored. The new schedule for the Conference itself (which is in the new pamphlet) will be sent to those that have preregistered along with a letter explaining other changes. Because of the phonning costs of arranging and postponning the Conference, a resolution was duely passed to direct the Conference tresurer to reimburse Mary N. & Joe B. for 50 dollers each. The final item discussed was the necessity of having a list of important areas of work for the Caucus and/or any other organization that might be formed at or Participate in Pride '78.
