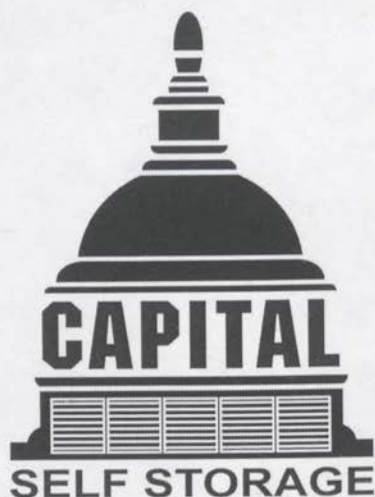

We are delighted that you are here!

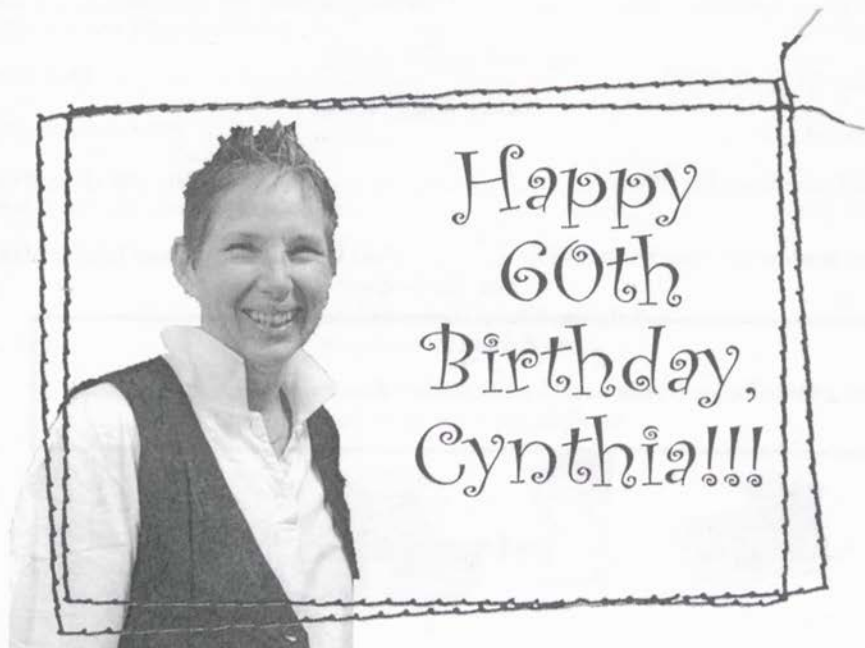

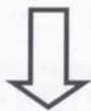

Victor Fields, Artistic Director, is a versatile choral conductor, organist, pianist and teacher. He is currently the Associate Conductor and Staff Accompanist for the Harrisburg Choral Society. He is also the Director of Music and Organist at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, York, Organist and Pianist at Temple Beth Israel, York, as well as an Adjunct Professor of Music at Mount St. Mary's University in Emmitsburg, Maryland. He has performed solo keyboard recitals in the Northeast, the South and California, and was a featured organ soloist with the York Symphony Orchestra in 2013. He has traveled and performed with various choral organizations in the US and in six European countries. He earned his music degrees and training from Mansfield

University (PA), The Peabody Conservatory of Music and the University of Cincinnati, College-Conservatory of Music. He has been a prize winner of several organ competitions from the Harrisburg, Baltimore and Richmond Chapters of American Guild of Organists, and the recipient of several competition scholarships and music awards from the Peabody and Cincinnati Conservatories.

Jordan R Markham, Accompanist, is an alumnus of *The Peabody Conservatory of The Johns Hopkins University*. He is a classically trained singer. He was a chorister at The National Cathedral and a chorister and soloist in The Handel Choir of Baltimore for two seasons. Throughout the past decade, Mr. Markham has performed with The Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, at Carnegie Hall, The Boston Symphony Hall, and The Jackie Gleason Theatre with auditioned choirs led by some of the most esteemed directors. In more recent years he has performed on-stage with the Peabody Opera department in Mozart's *Die Zauberflöte* and *Così fan tutte*, Verdi's *La Traviata*, and Leoš Janáček's *The Cunning Little Vixen*. He currently serves as organist and choir-master at Gloria Dei Lutheran church in Arnold, Maryland.



Renee Bartholomew, percussion and Patricia George, percussion and bass, have played with many area bands. They often join CPWC for its concerts.
